### Greetings!

This is a last minute newsletter to remind you how to cope with the impending deadline of April 17, 2012. You can get an extension of time to file your return, but this does not extend the time to pay your tax due. If you pay the same amount as last year, you will not be penalized if you should owe more tax this year.

The extension to file your 2011 tax return is for 6 months. Don't wait until October to complete your tax return because interest does accrue on any unpaid balance.

If you can file, but cannot pay the bill in full, an installment agreement is a way to spread out the payment into something more manageable. Please call our office for more details at 215.951.5585.

Although the individual tax season is coming to a close, please don't hesitate to call us if you should need estimated tax payments, installment agreements or help with accounting, payroll, Not for Profit or City of Philadelphia issues.
